Free loan payments via Elecsnet terminals for Citibank clients

The terminals network has additional advantage, which is Elecsnet's direct work with Citibank rather than intermediary organizations like many other payment system providers do. Elecsnet ensures that the funds are credited to the account even if the terminal or the money from it is stolen.

The service offered jointly with Elecsnet is yet another innovative feature made available to Citibank clients, along with loan-related payment services such as "e-statement", sms-alerts, regular automatic Citi direct debit credit card balance payment service.
